## Vintage 2009

89 p.

*The 2009 Valpolicella Superiore Morandina opens with super ripe red cherries, flowers and mint. Hints of sweet herbs, licorice and fennel develop in the glass, adding complexity and nuance. The style is understated and nuanced; in other words perfect for drinking over the next few years. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2017. Pra does so many things well its hard to know where to start. All five wines I tasted were terrific. I can't think of too many wineries in Veneto that excel to this degree with both whites and reds.*



## Vintage 2009

89 p.

This open-knit and smoky red offers flavors of macerated cherry, crème de cassis and dried herb, with lots of ground spice notes. Fresh, showing a hint of gum drop on the moderate finish. Drink now through 2017.'



## Vintage 2016

90 p.

'A fruity and fresh red with sliced strawberry and lemon character. Medium body. Clean and vivid finish. Drink now'

## Vintage 2014

92 p.

'A light red showing incredible purity on the nose with red cherries, wild strawberries, hints of rose petals and white pepper. This is medium-bodied with enhancing juiciness, cherry character, and a mineral-like texture. Peppery too. Drink now.'
